



I used the 5x5 map from Mouse and Owl.

I printed 2 copies. The first I taped together to make a huge map. I used this one for reference and placement. The second I used as patterns to cut from.

I taped the patterns to the felt with clear Scotch tape to keep them still while I cut. I glued the pieces down with fabric glue. I pieced felt together to save some money but for Asia it would probably be easier to use a large yellow piece. Also note that I came up with my own line of division between Asia and Europe. It is “semi” correct - but not perfect by any means.

I printed the labels on card stock. I laminated one side and put permanent adhesive on the back (I have a Xyron) I stuck the cut out labels on felt and cut them out a second time.

Very time consuming but worth it!
